Brief Description / Purpose of the function:

You will be responsible for the maintenance and repair of the manufacturing / machining cells and plant facilities. Ensure that plant and equipment perform to the required standard, safely and effectively.

Main areas of responsibility are as follows, but are not limited to:

1. Diagnosing and solving electrical and mechanical breakdowns, effectively and efficiently.
2. Assisting maintenance manager with ordering of replacement parts and spare parts provisioning.
3. Ensuring continuous running of the production line (Machine Up Time – OEE)_through effective preventative maintenance and close coordination with Mfg Teams.
4. Plan and execute a variety of projects as part of the maintenance team.
5. Lead scheduled maintenance on all equipment with minimal downtime.
6. Support building maintenance actions and 5S Lean process expectations.
7. Support strategic capital investment projects including new equipment purchases, capacity expansion, and Facility improvements.
8. Support various action plans to implement new productivity concepts, safety and ergonomic improvements.
9. Keep accurate reports of the elements within any given task, as necessary.
